MONTHLY MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Chair Waldron at 7:03 p.m. with a statement of compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice to The Trenton Times, City Hall Bulletin Board, and various individuals.

ROLL CALL

All Commissioners were present.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chair Waldron.

MEETING MINUTES

A motion was made by Vice Chair Hayes to approve the minutes from March 18, 2025, and April 15, 2025 and the workshop meeting minutes from May 4, 2025 and June 2, 2025, and seconded by Treasurer von Uffel. A voice vote was taken, MOTION PASSES.

COMMISSIONER ITEMS

- Treasurer von Uffel presented the Treasurers Report. The total in checking account is \$395,645.33 and savings is \$274,903.45. Chair Waldron made a motion to approve the Treasurers Report and Vice Chair Hayes seconded. A voice vote was taken, MOTION PASSES.

CHIEFS REPORT

- There were 36 calls in April and 27 calls in May.
- All drone training has been completed per grant.
- A truck is needed to pull the boat.
- In talks with Delaware Township regarding expanding the fire bureau. Other towns may be interested.

OLD BUSINESS

- Due to the sale of the building, new W9's are needed for tax purposes. They are coming in.

NEW BUSINESS

- Commissioner von Uffel made a motion to send a \$100.00 donation to North Penn Good Will Fire, Commissioner Barna seconded, a voice vote was taken, MOTION PASSED.
- The Commissioners received a letter from Fleetwing Fire. They will be attending the workshop session on July 6, 2025, to discuss further.
- Chair Waldron made a motion to engage with M. Burns regarding bunk rooms, Commissioner Barna seconded, a voice vote was taken, MOTION PASSED.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

- Don Hart gave an update on the progress of Union Fire's new building. He is going to have information to the Commissioners by July 7, 2025, regarding sub-metering from the District. He suggested if the Commissioners want to use any of the contractors they are using, start talking with them now.
