MONTHLY MEETING

MEETING MINUTES

COMMISSIONER ITEMS

- The next Fire Commission working session will be a visit to Hamilton Fire to look at a city pumper, quint, tiller, and heavy rescue engine. The date will be scheduled soon.

CHIEFS REPORT

- Total of 34 calls for the month of August.
- Fire Prevention Bureau was successful in acquiring the LEA for Delaware Township effective date of 1/1/26.
- The City has asked the department to provide a QRS (quick response service) to support the EMS service. It began on August 29 and will continue for the foreseeable future.
- All equipment is in good working condition.

OLD BUSINESS

- Burns Architecture is working on plans for the bunkroom.

NEW BUSINESS

- Chair Waldron made a motion to pass Resolution 25-117 for Provide LEA for Delaware Township. Vice Chair Hayes seconded, a voice vote was taken, MOTION PASSES.
- Vice Chair Hayes made a motion to sign the construction letter. Commissioner Barna seconded, a voice vote was taken, MOTION PASSES.
- It has been communicated to Firefighter Siwy that the district no longer recognizes collective bargaining. He will continue with the Union Healthcare.
- Chair Waldron made a motion to pass Resolution 25-118 to hire per diem firefighters Tyler Bruno, Stephen Hayworth, Steven Velazques, and Daniel Dix at \$16.00 per hour. Commissioner Barna seconded, a voice vote was taken, MOTION PASSES.
